Romans 12:9-21

- 9 Let love be genuine.
Abhor what is evil;
hold fast to what is good.
- 10 Love one another with brotherly affection.
Outdo one another in showing honor.
- 11 Do not be slothful in zeal,
be fervent in spirit,
serve the Lord.
- 12 Rejoice in hope,
be patient in tribulation,
be constant in prayer.
- 13 Contribute to the needs of the saints
and seek to show hospitality.
- 14 Bless those who persecute you;
bless and do not curse them.
- 15 Rejoice with those who rejoice,
weep with those who weep.
- 16 Live in harmony with one another.
Do not be haughty,
but associate with the lowly.
Never be wise in your own sight.
- 17 Repay no one evil for evil,
but give thought to do what is honorable in the sight of all.
- 18 If possible, so far as it depends on you,
live peaceably with all.
- 19 Beloved, never avenge yourselves,
but leave it to the wrath of God,
for it is written,
“Vengeance is mine,
I will repay, says the Lord.”
- 20 To the contrary,
“if your enemy is hungry, feed him;
if he is thirsty, give him something to drink;
for by so doing you will heap burning coals on his head.”
- 21 Do not be overcome by evil,
but overcome evil with good. (ESV)

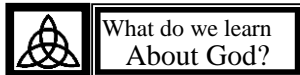

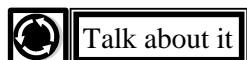
