## Devotional Exposition of Romans 6:1-14 (Colossians 3:1-4)

- Chapters 1:1–3:20 First he gives the bad news: The world is condemned (no exceptions)
- Chapter 3:21-31 The Good News: God, apart from the Law, in Christ, made all provisions necessary for man to stand with God.
- Chapter 4 Free faith, declared righteous
- Chapter 5 Adam as our representative provided death for all; we are all dead in Adam. God in Christ escorts you back into the garden. In Christ you get all you lost in Adam.
- Chapters 6-7 All the problems are not solved. It depends on our reliance on God. To yield to or obey God.
