– What does the repetition reveal about God?

- Circle—every reference to God’s purpose
- Underline—every reference to God’s glory
- Number—every blessing of the believer
- Mark—“in Christ” “in Him”

Ephesians 1:3-14

Every spiritual blessing to the praise of His glory 1:3-14

- **Plan:** Father elected us in eternity past 1:3-6
 - Blessed
 - Chosen
 - Predestined for adoption as son
- To be holy and blameless adopted sons

Salvation Determined by the Father—Past

Ephesians 1:3-14

Every spiritual blessing to the praise of His glory 1:3-14

- **Plan:** Father elected us in eternity past 1:3-6
 - **Provision:** Son redeemed us in the historical present 1:7-12
 - Redemption and Forgiveness
 - Making known His plan—"One"
 - Inheritance
 - Superabounding grace
 - Redeemed, Forgiven, Informed and Inheritance
- Salvation Provided by the Son—Present*

Ephesians 1:3-14

Every spiritual blessing to the praise of His glory 1:3-14

- **Plan:** Father elected us in eternity past 1:3-6
- **Provision:** Son redeemed us in the historical present 1:7-12
- **Protected:** Spirit sealed us individually in the past for the future 1:13-14
 - Sealed inheritance

Salvation Secured by the Spirit—Future

Ephesians 1:1-14

- Paul writes to those in Christ 1:1-2
- About: Every Spiritual Blessing to the praise of His glory 1:3-14
 - Plan, Provision and Protection of Salvation
